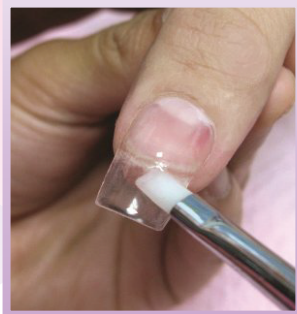


BASIC ONE CLEAR GEL TUTORIAL



STEP BY STEP • HOW TO TUTORIAL

1. Sanitize and prep the nails as usual. Remove shine from nails. Cleanse all 10 nails with Basic One Wiping Solution then wait until completely dry.
2. Polish thin layer of Basic One Clear Gel 1/8" away from cuticle to the tip/edge of the nail. Drip small drop of gel in the middle of nail to create thickness. Cure nail for one minute or less under an LED/UV Lamp. Repeat on the same finger of the opposite hand. Alternate fingers until all ten are done.
3. Apply another thin coat of Basic One Clear Gel to entire nail. Drip and drag gel to add thickness or to shape nail as desired. Cure nail for one minute or less, alternating fingers until all ten are done.
4. Once all ten nails are completely done with second layer of Basic One Clear Gel, cure all ten nails for another 3 minutes (3-5 minutes, depending on thickness).
5. Remove all sticky residue with Basic One Wiping Solution. Lightly smooth out the edges of all 10 nails. Cleanse nails with Basic One Wiping Solution again to remove all the dust off bed. Can either wear the nails clear or apply regular polish as desired.

Please Note:

- If entire gel nails are soft and peel off within hours/days, this means that the nails were under cured.
- If nails break/crack, are bendable, or chip/crack; this means that the gel application was too thin.
- If gel lifts around cuticle area, this means lack of prepping. If necessary, for oily nails, wipe with Wiping Solution twice prior to gel application.
